Ben Elliott has been flameworking since 2000. In his early years of glass, he experimented on his own while enrolling in the sculpture program at the University of Asheville-North Carolina. After completing his degree in 2005, Ben moved to Ohio and began the MFA program in glass at Kent State University. During his graduate career, he taught introductory classes. Upon returning to western North Carolina, he has been an instructor at Jackson County Green Energy Park as well as assisting other regional artists and setting up his own studio. Currently Ben is active as an instructor and a participating member at the Asheville Glass Center.

Ben's works are fragments of a familiar story unfolding through time and cycles of life. Each piece is a personal narrative that may come from a memory, something that is occurring in the present, or future projections of things that may happen in his life. Using archetypal imagery as a common thread to pull others into a story, his intent is to evoke a thought or memory for the viewer using minimal information.
